### **Outer Cape Energize Extends Solarize Pricing to December 31, 2018**

**Wellfleet, MA:** After a highly successful Solarize Mass program, including a one-month extension due to strong demand, the formal program has ended with the Massachusetts Clean Energy Center (MassCEC). In participating in the Solarize Mass program, Outer Cape Energize made large strides in educating Outer Cape residents about solar energy and through public outreach, more than 300 Outer Cape homeowners expressed interest in converting to solar energy. Since the program started **90 solar systems** have been purchased, representing over **631.3 kW** of solar photovoltaic (PV) capacity, to generate clean energy year after year following installation.

However, Outer Cape Energize and ACE Solar want to keep the momentum going to get to a total of 800 kW worth of contracted systems by December 31, 2018. Please help us reach this major milestone with the purchase of a solar PV system for your house or business. On top of helping us reach our goal, you'll benefit in three ways:

- You will reduce your carbon emissions, helping to create a cleaner environment!
- You will save money! ACE Solar has agreed to continue the Tier One pricing from our Solarize Mass program, providing savings of at least 20% off standard pricing.
